

GENERAL INFORMATION

The War on the Floor is a BC WRESTLING tournament which is run with the assistance of SFU, and Burnaby Mountain Wrestling Club volunteers. Proceeds from this tournament support the BC Wrestling provincial development programs.

COACHES:

Please help us to run an enjoyable and valuable meet. We need your assistance in controlling vandalism, theft and misconduct. Please remind your team of their expected behaviour in the venue, at the hotel, and in the community while representing our sport and your school.

RULES:

- Cheques payable to BC Wrestling Association (BCWA) for tournament entry & BC Wrestling membership.
- ALL tournament entry fees & membership fees (or proof of provincial/state membership) must be paid at registration prior to the start of tournament.
- Tournament entry fees must be paid at the registration table by the team coach, or designated coach, NOT each individual athlete.
- Late entries WILL NOT be accepted into the tournament.
- Modified freestyle rules.
- Weight challenges must be placed PRIOR to third round.
- Ensure that your weigh-ins are accurate and that athletes are ON or UNDER the weight class in which they are entered.
- Pay particular attention to skin problems. If questionable, DO NOT enter the athlete.
- Deadline for Grade 9-12 novice athletes entering the elite, must be entered by 4:00pm Thursday, and athletes MUST weigh in on Friday morning and obtain a weigh in slip. Novice athletes must place in the top 3 to enter into the Elite tournament.

WEIGHT DISCREPANCIES:

There will be a challenge process for anyone in the novice age class, for a \$20.00 fee. All athletes must be within 2 kg of the officially registered weight class at the time of the challenge. If athlete is challenged and is over, the athlete will be disqualified and money returned to the challenger. IF COACHES ARE CONSCIENTIOUS AT WEIGH-IN TIME, WE SHOULD HAVE NO NEED FOR ANY CHALLENGES. Please approach table for weight challenges.

ENTRY FEE & MEMBERSHIP : All BC participants MUST be registered members of BCWA (membership must be completed and paid in full to enter tournament). Out of province/country, must provide proof of membership with provincial/state association, or purchase BCWA membership. A \$25. surcharge will be added for any invoicing. Please note that it is recommended that you submit your membership fees in advance of the War on the Floor Tournament in order to speed up the tournament registration process. Also, please note that ONLY head Coaches can submit tournament fees for the team. No individual athlete fees will be accepted. **PAYABLE TO BC WRESTLING**

NOVICE DEFINITION:

If an athlete PLACED in the TOP SIX at a provincial/state or national championships, they are NOT ELIGIBLE to compete in ANY of the novice categories. Coaches PLEASE use discretion when entering athletes.

GRADES 6-7-8 NOVICE (MANUAL DRAW)

Coaches please use discretion when entering athletes into novice category

REGISTRATION: 11:00 – 12:00 noon START: 1:00 PM

ENTRY FEE: \$15.00 per athlete

ELIGIBILITY:

Any student, grade 6,7 & 8, that has not medaled in a tournament at the age category they are entering with four or more entries in their weight class. Gr. 6, 7, 8 athletes who DO NOT qualify as novice can enter grade 9-10 novice.

WEIGHT DIVISIONS:

MEN: 36, 38, 41, 45, 48, 51, 54, 57, 60, 63, 66, 70, 74, & *74+ KG.

WOMEN: 36, 40, 43, 47, 51, 54, 57, 60, 64, 69 & * 69+ KG.

(*heaviest weights to be pooled: indicate exact weight in kg for + divisions)

AWARDS: Top three placers in each weight class

ENTRY:

Names & weights must be emailed (format requested ONLY) to info@bcwrestling.com before 6:00pm Monday, Dec. 5, 2011. All entries must be submitted together by the team coach to avoid duplicate entries from the athlete. Coaches will receive confirmation when your entry is received.

NO LATE ENTRIES

NOVICE DEFINITION:

If an athlete **PLACED** in the **TOP SIX** at a provincial/state or national championships, they are **NOT ELIGIBLE** to compete in ANY of the novice categories. Coaches PLEASE use discretion when entering athletes.

GRADE 9-12 NOVICE (MANUAL DRAW)

Coaches please use discretion when entering athletes into novice category

REGISTRATION: 7:30-9:00am (NO DROPS after 9 am)
Grade 9 – 10 10:00 am start
Grade 11 - 12 1:00 pm start

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 per athlete
\$10.00/CO meal pass/day

ELIGIBILITY:

Any student, grade 9-12, that has not medaled in a tournament with four or more entries in their weight class, at the age category they are entering. We ask coaches to use discretion and to place grade 10 wrestlers who are experienced, into the 11-12 division.

WEIGHT DIVISIONS:

9-10 Men: 38, 41, 45, 48, 51, 54, 57, 60, 63, 66, 70, 74, 78, 90, *90+KG.

9-10 Women: 36, 38, 40, 43, 47, 51, 54, 57, 60, 64, 69, & * 69+ KG.

11-12 Men: 41, 45, 48, 51, 54, 57, 60, 63, 66, 70, 74, 78, 84, 90, 110, 130

11-12 Women: 40, 43, 47, 51, 54, 57, 60, 64, 69, 75 & *75+ KG

(*heaviest weights to be pooled: indicate exact weight in kg for + divisions)

AWARDS: Top three placers in each weight class.

ENTRY

Names & weights must be emailed (in format requested only) to info@bcwrestling.com BEFORE 6:00pm Tues, Dec. 6. All entries must be submitted together, by the team coach, to avoid duplicate entries from the athlete. Coaches will receive confirmation when your entry is received and reviewed. (one division per day per person only)

LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

ELITE DEADLINE: NOVICE ENTRIES competing in Friday's ELITE division must have placed in top 3, and must register by Thursday @ 4pm – ALL athletes entering the Elite must obtain a weigh in slip and then WEIGH in on FRIDAY morning at 7:00am.

** Be exact and strict on weights as changes are very difficult to make at the time of competition. Weigh-ins are to be conducted by coaches only. Athletes must be on or below the weight category that they are entered (i.e. an athlete weighing 54.2 KGs. would compete at 57Kg. weight class).

HIGH SCHOOL ELITE (COMPUTER DRAW)

REGISTRATION: 7:00 – 8:30 am Start: 10:00am

WEIGH IN: 7:00 - 8:30 am **Weigh in at SFU
All wrestlers must have a weigh in card to weigh in.

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 per athlete.
\$10.00/CO meal pass/day

ELIGIBILITY:

Any grade 8-12 student, including those who have medaled in a novice or elite tournament. Open to out-of- province.

WEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Men: 41, 45, 48, 51, 54, 57, 60, 63, 66, 70, 74, 78, 84, 90, 110, 130

Women: 40, 43, 47, 51, 54, 57, 60, 64, 69, 75 & *75+ KG

(*heaviest weights to be pooled: indicate exact weight in kg for + divisions)

AWARDS: Top 3 placers per weight / Outstanding male& female
