WHAT ARE THE NORTH AMERICAN INDIGENOUS GAMES?

The Team BC NAIG program provides 520 Indigenous athletes with the opportunity to celebrate their culture and experience a major sport competition. The Indigenous Sport, Physical Activity & Recreation Council delivers an annual series of BC Indigenous Provincial Championships and Sport Development Camps in various communities across the province. There are 16 different sports with three traditional Indigenous sports including Canoe/Kayak, Lacrosse, and Archery.

WHERE ARE THE EVENTS DELIVERED?

Kjipuktuk, as it is called by the Mi'kmaw Nation will host competitions in 16 sports over seven days and within 21 venues across Kjipuktuk (Halifax), Dartmouth and Millbrook First Nation, Nova Scotia.

NAIG 2023 will bring together more than 5000 athletes, coaches and team staff from 756 Indigenous Nations celebrating, sharing and reconnecting through sport and culture with the help of 3000 volunteers.
