## WHAT IS THE EXTERNAL SPORT CREDIT PROGRAM?

External Sport Credentials Program provides wrestling students credits toward graduation through the Athletes Program, Official Program, and Coach Program.

Athletes Program:	Athlete 10, BC Summer Games Team Athlete 12, Provincial Team - Juvenile, Provincial Team - Cadet
Official Program:	Official 10, BC Official-C Official 11, BC Official-B Official 12, BC Official-A
Coach Program:	Coach 11, NCCP certifications + Practical coach experience verification letter + Making Ethical Decisions "Evaluated" module

## WHO CAN RECEIVE CREDITS?

Grade 10-12 students in British Columbia.

## WHY SHOULD STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM?

Students will receive credits towards graduation will building on their skill set as an athlete, official, and or coach.

## HOW DO I RECEIVE CREDITS?

### ATHLETES

Students who have met the requirements of an approved athlete program are to email the BCWA Executive Director, at [execdirector@bcwrestling.com](mailto:execdirector@bcwrestling.com), to request a verification letters to be submitted to the student's school administrator.

Team BC athletes who compete at the Canada Games will be sent a verification letter by the BC Games Society shortly after the completion of the games.

### COACHES

Once all program criteria are met, students can submit completion documents to the BCWA Executive Director, at [execdirector@bcwrestling.com](mailto:execdirector@bcwrestling.com), for review. BCWA will issue a verification letter to the student to be submitted to the student's school administrator.

Students must complete: A theory component, an exam (written or oral), and have practical officiating experience (that is evaluated and signed by an authorized organization or club representative).

### OFFICIALS

Student coaches seeking to earn credit under the Coach 11 category must provide proof of completion for all required program components to the Sport Branch, Ministry of Tourism, Arts, Culture. And Sport.

Required documentation includes:

-NCCP certifications - Practical coach experience verification letter -Making Ethical Decisions "Evaluated" module

**\*A verification letter will be sent directly to a student if they have fulfilled all the requirements.**
