RECIPROCATION POLICY

1. PURPOSE

- a. The purpose of this Policy is to ensure national enforcement and recognition of all disciplinary sanctions applied by BCWA, WCL, PTSOs, Canadian Association of Wrestling Officials (CAWO), and Clubs.

2. APPLICATION OF THIS POLICY

- a. This Policy applies to all Participants, BCWA, WCL, PTSOs, CAWO, and Clubs.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES

- a. BCWA will:
 - i. Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions involving Participants to WCL, all PTSOs, and to the Club(s) with which the Participant was affiliated
 - ii. For discipline decisions provided to BCWA by WCL, a PTSO, CAWO, or by a Club, determine per the Discipline and Complaints Policy whether to initiate further action against the Participant(s) named in the decision
 - iii. Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by WCL, a PTSO, CAWO, and/or a Club
 - iv. Previous decisions in which the sanction is still enforceable, shall also be communicated to WCL, all PTSOs, and to the Club(s) for which the individual was affiliated
- b. WCL / PTSO / CAWO will:
 - i. Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions involving Participants to BCWA and to the Club(s) with which the Individual was affiliated
 - ii. For discipline decisions provided to WCL, a PTSO, and CAWO by BCWA or by a Club, determine per its own policies whether to initiate further action against the Individual(s) named in the decision
 - iii. Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by BCWA and/or a Club
 - iv. Update their governing documents to reference the reciprocity procedures described herein
- c. Clubs will:
 - i. Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions involving Participants to WCL and to the PTSO with which the Club is affiliated
 - ii. For discipline decisions provided to a Club by BCWA, WCL, or by a PTSO, determine per its own policies whether to initiate further action against the Individual(s) named in the decision
 - iii. Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by BCWA, WCL, and/or a PTSO
 - iv. Update their governing documents to reference the reciprocity procedures described herein

4. APPEALS

- a. The recognition and implementation of a sanction in accordance with this Policy is not appealable.
