INTRODUCTION TO WRESTLING COMPETITION

WHAT IS THE ZONE MINI MEET PROGRAM?

BC Wrestling Association to organize local novice events to provide athletes with experience of a structured wrestling competition. Utilize the program to promote wrestling locally while delivering level appropriate training and engaging communities.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

With BCWA leading the organization and delivery of the program and supported by Zone Representatives, local coaches, and local schools, this program will be available to athletes in Grades 8 to 12. All grades 8 and 9 athletes are permitted to participate. Grades 10 to 12 athletes may participate if it is their first year of wrestling.

WHERE ARE THE EVENTS DELIVERED?

All Zones in BC may participate in the program. Each Zone may have up to two events delivery each BCWA membership year in the selected local community.

WHEN ARE THE EVENTS?

Events will be delivered between November to March, during the school season of play. Events will be scheduled for after school hours with a duration of three hours each.

WHY IS THE PROGRAM NECESSARY?

To provide local training and competition opportunities for athletes in a professional setting with skill level appropriate activities.

For BCWA to step up and alleviate some of the responsibilities of local coaches.

HOW WILL BCWA DELIVER THE PROGRAM?

BCWA will deliver Zone Mini Meets through the support and partnership with Zone Representatives, local coaches, school districts, and provincial and federal funding programs.
